CALL TO ORDER

The Council met in the Chambers of the City Building at 5:30 P.M., for the fourth meeting in the month of April on the 18th day, in the year 2017, and was called to order by the Honorable Mayor, Danny Jones. The invocation was delivered by Councilmember Harrison and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilmember Webb. REPORTS OF COMMITTEES

COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

Councilmember Bobby Reishman, Chairman of the Council Committee on Finance, submitted the following report:

1. Your committee on Finance has had under consideration Bill No. 7741, and reports the same to Council with the recommendation that the bill do pass.

<u>Bill No. 7741</u>: A Bill and Order relating to the laying of levies on real, personal and public utility property within the City of Charleston, West Virginia, including excess levies previously provided for in the Official Municipal Budget Document for the fiscal year beginning the first day of July, two thousand seventeen.

WHEREAS, written approval of the West Virginia State Tax Commissioner has been received and notice of the Levy Estimate has been duly published as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the levy rate attached hereto is included in the City of Charleston Municipal Budget for July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018, before City Council for approval at a special meeting of Council held on April 18, 2017; and

WHEREAS, each Municipality in West Virginia is required to hold a Statutory meeting of the Council on the third Tuesday in April each year to make and enter a levy order; and

WHEREAS, the first reading of this Bill has been accomplished at an emergency meeting of City Council on April 11, 2017, the facts and circumstances surrounding the emergency being that an imminent material financial loss would occur if this Bill is not permitted to be considered for passage at a properly noticed special meeting of City Council on April 18, 2017, in accordance with the requirements of W. Va. Code §11-8-14a; now, therefore

Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Charleston, West Virginia:

That the City of Charleston, West Virginia does hereby make and enter the levy order attached hereto, incorporated herein, and made a part hereof.
